Student achievement, 2010-2011 academic year

SUMMARY

As measured by several external assessments:

- Stamford Academy students grew 3.1 grade levels in reading and 1.1 grade levels in math as measured by NWEA.
- Trailblazers Academy students grew 1.6 grade levels in reading as measured by QRI and 1.2 grade levels in math as measured by STAR.
- Domus Academy New Haven students grew 1.7 grade levels in reading and 2.6 grade levels in math as measured by STAR.

STAMFORD ACADEMY

- 91% of SA seniors received an acceptance letter to the post-secondary opportunity of their choice before graduation.
- SA reading scores went from 6.9% proficient to 31.6%, the highest level of reading proficiency ever reached at SA.
- SA writing scores went from 6.9% proficient to 38.1% proficient, the highest level of writing proficiency ever reached at SA.
- In math, 47% of students averaged 1.5 grade levels of growth or better.
- 80% of students averaged at least 1.5 grade levels of growth in reading.

DOMUS ACADEMY (first year of operation)

- **6th grade:** 75% of students scored goal in reading (as opposed to 20% the year prior, so a 55% increase) and 20% proficient. 10% scored proficient in writing (as opposed to 57% the year prior). 33% scored proficient in math (no change in math). Versus NHPS we were 39% less proficient in math, 24% more proficient in reading, and 61% less proficient in writing.
- **7th grade:** 80% scored goal in reading (0 for NHPS year prior) and 80% @ proficiency (as opposed to 20% the year prior). 0% at goal and proficiency in writing (no change from year prior). Math 80% proficient (as opposed to 0% the year prior). Versus NHPS 5% we were more proficient in math, 5% were more proficient in reading, and 57% were less proficient in writing.
- **8th grade:** 53% of students scored proficient in reading and 46% at goal (as opposed to 0% the year prior). 6% scored proficient in writing (as opposed to 0% the year prior). 33% of students scored proficient in math (no change from prior year). Science 6% of students scored proficient (as opposed to 52% the year prior).

TRAILBLAZERS ACADEMY

According to the CMT, TA 8th graders with us for all three years entered the school performing lower than any other group of charter school middle schoolers, the Stamford Public Schools middle school average, or the State average, but their growth over their TA career met or exceeded that of almost every other group, despite how far behind they were.

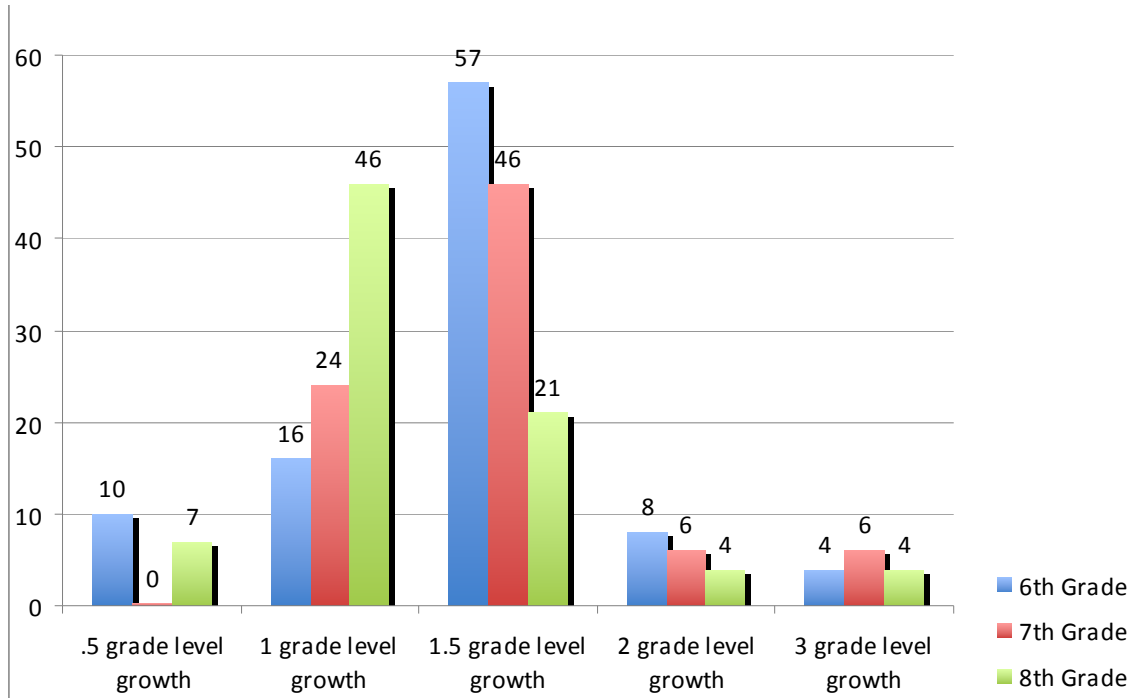
