**Why Domus?** Domus is a Stamford-based nonprofit created in 1972 to help the region's most vulnerable children. We started as a home for 7 homeless boys and now help 1,700 traumatized, neglected, or struggling boys, girls, and young adults through our schools, community, and re-entry programs. *Definition of Social Justice:* the view that everyone deserves equal economic, political, and social rights and opportunities. Social justice efforts aim to open the doors of access and opportunity for everyone, particularly those in greatest need.
